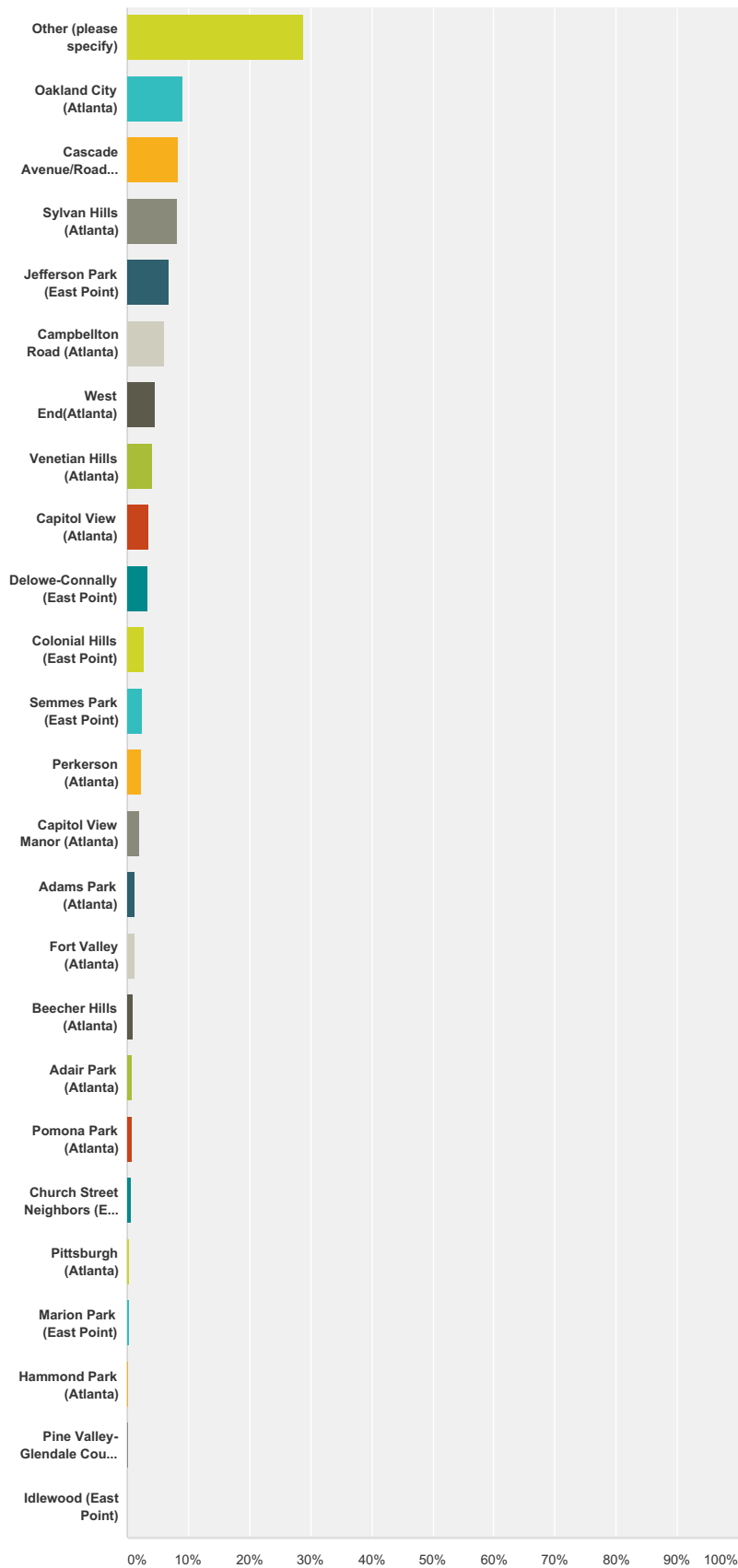

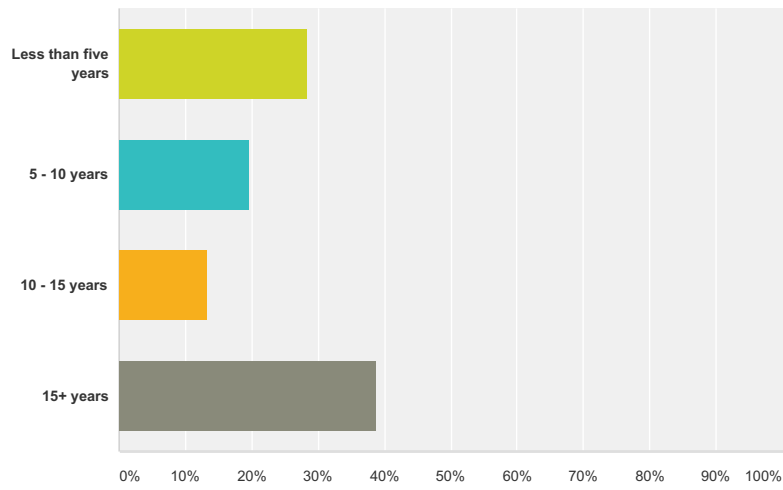

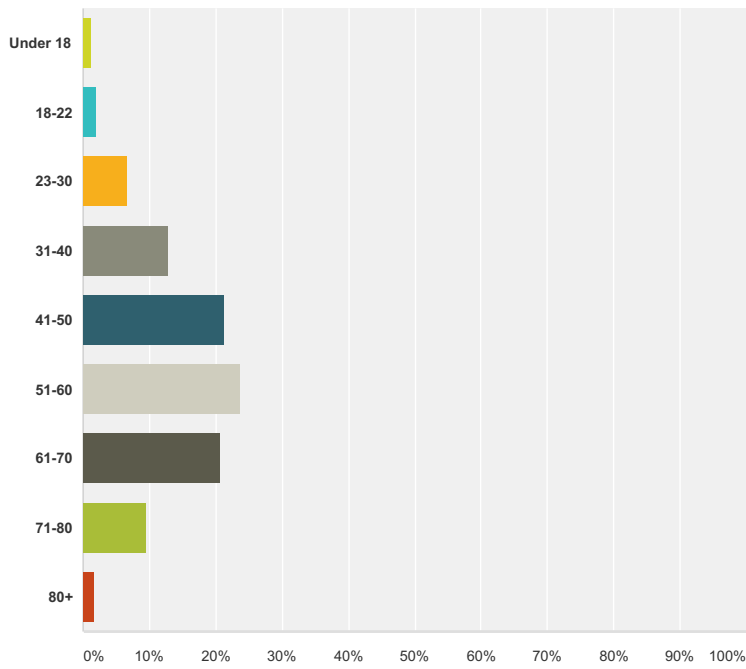

Q3 How old are you?

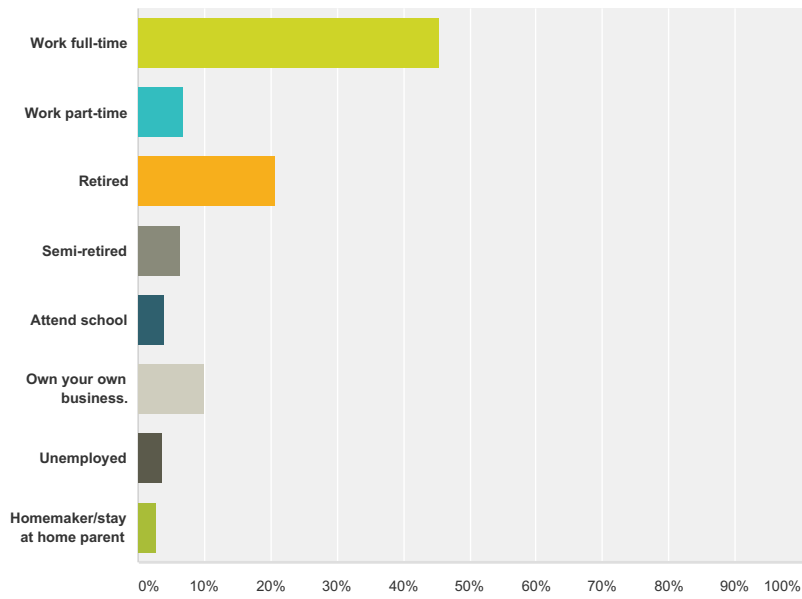

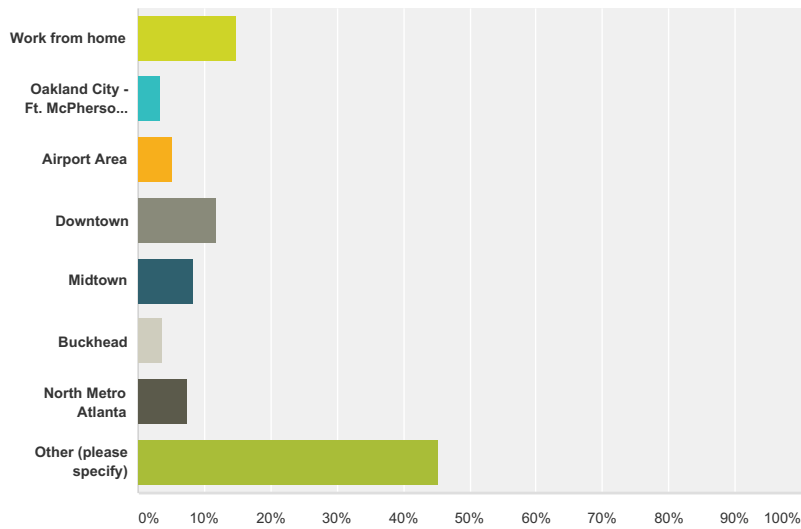

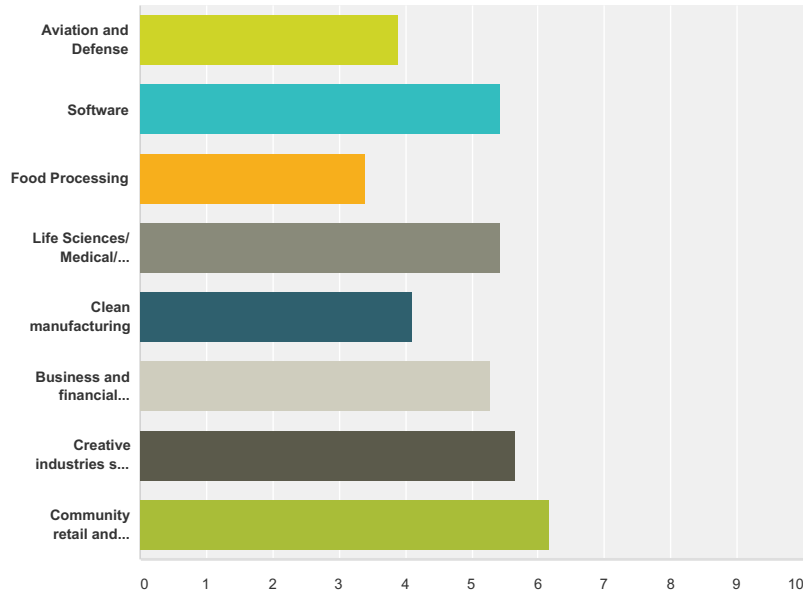

Q8 Prioritize the types of businesses/industries we should try to grow and attract

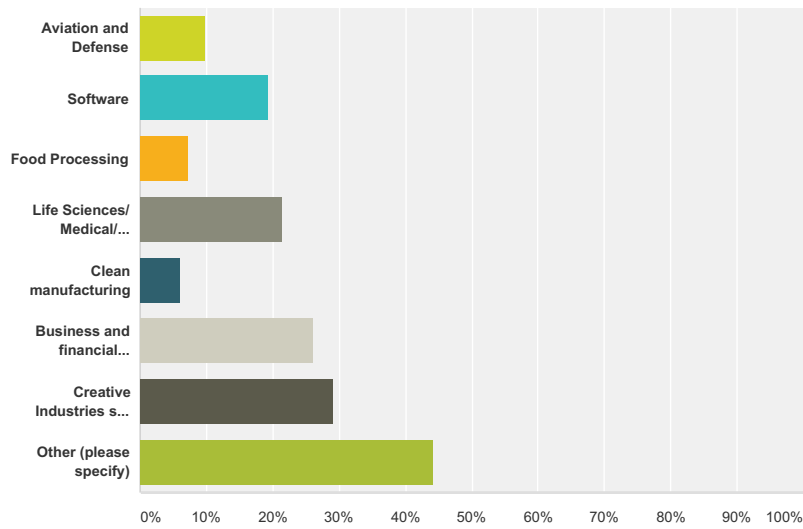

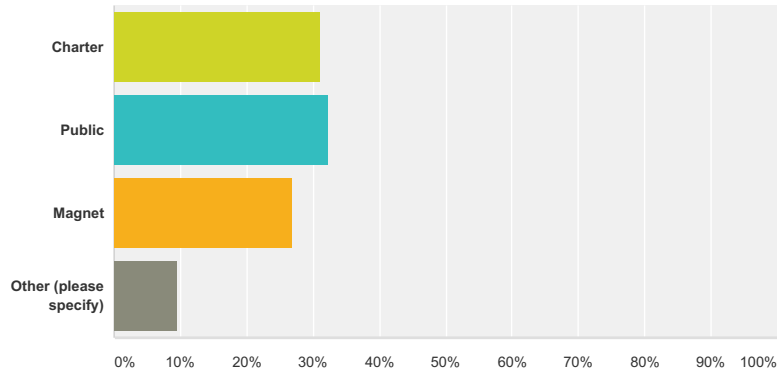
