ATTENTION RESPONDENTS

<u>In the insurance section, there is an adjustment that is necessary and supersedes the original document:</u>

"General Liability. The surveying consultant, with respect to all liability other than for professional acts, errors, or omissions, shall indemnify, defend, hold and save harmless the Consultant, and the Client, their officers and employees, from liability of any nature or kind, including costs and expenses, for or on account of any or all claims or suits for damages of any character whatsoever arising from acts, omissions or conduct of the surveying consultant, its employees and agents, and the surveying consultant's subcontractors, and suppliers, their employees and agents."

Survey RFP Question:

Could the following question be addressed for the above referenced RFP?

1. Would Fort Mac LRA consider extending the RFP due date a week to allow respondents additional time to prepare and submit proposals?

Fort Mac LRA Response:

In response to your question for an extension of time, Fort Mac LRA will **NOT** be extending the deadline for RFP package submissions. The due date remains April 12, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. E.D.T.
