

FACILITY OVERVIEW, BUILDING 171: POST HOSPITAL USE

Building 171 (1593 Hardee Avenue) is situated in the Historic Village, in the northeast corner of Fort McPherson and south of Troop Row. The two-story, T-shaped, irregular-core brick building is connected to building 170 via a two-story enclosed brick hyphen.

The building was constructed in 1889 and was used as a post hospital building. The US Army reports the square footage as approximately 34,114 sq.ft.

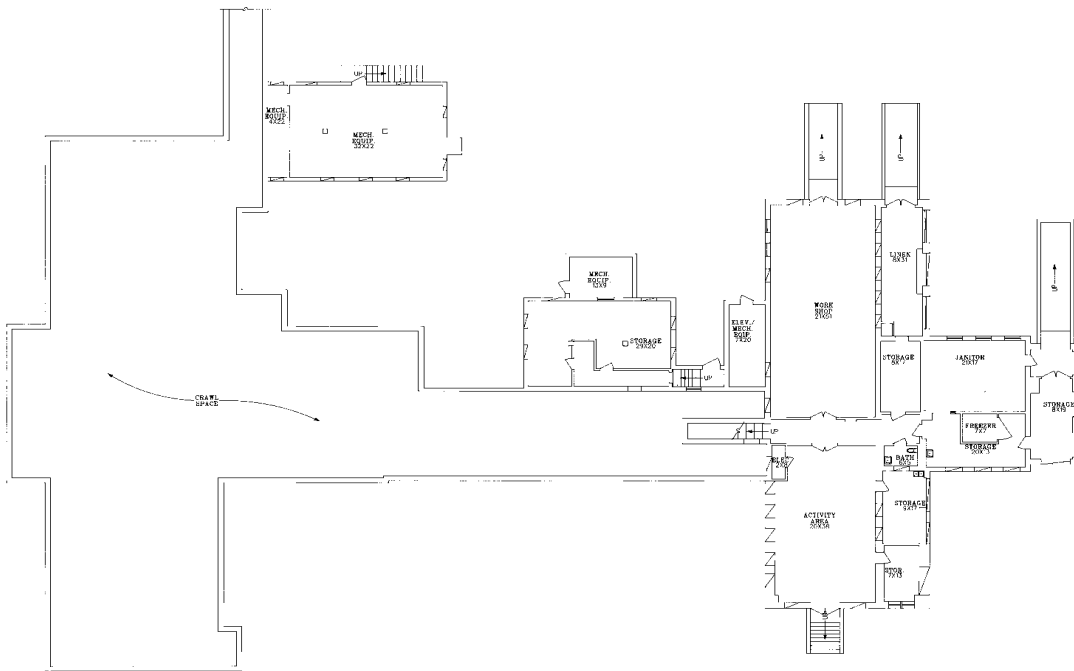


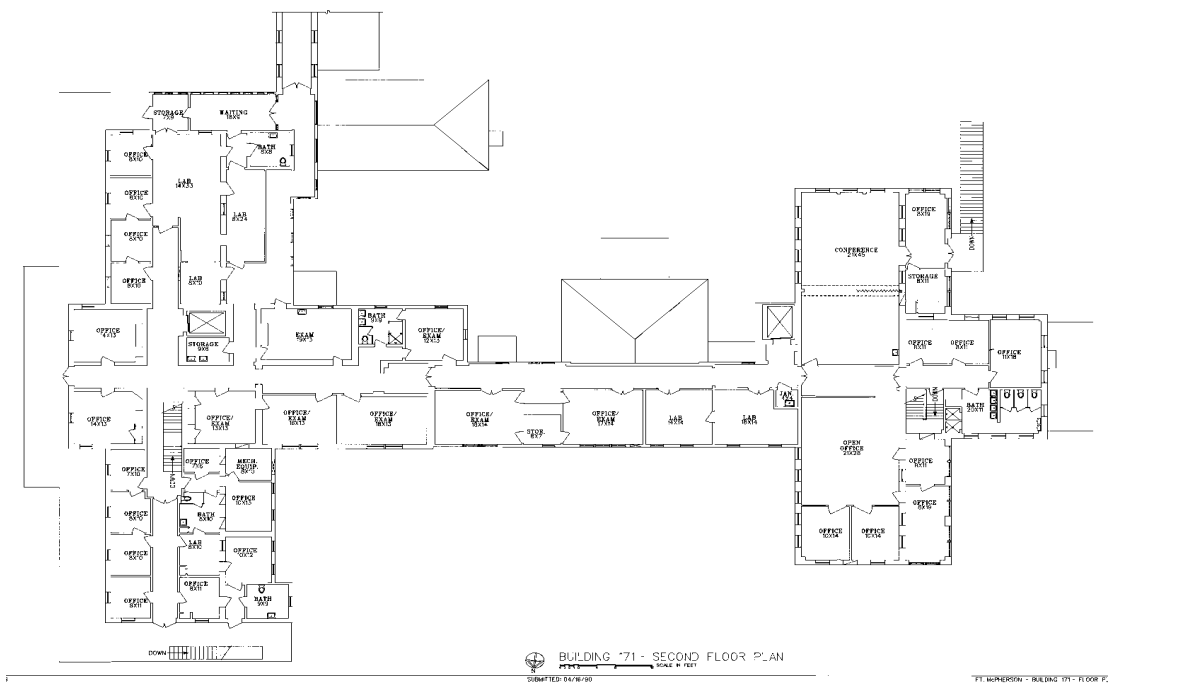
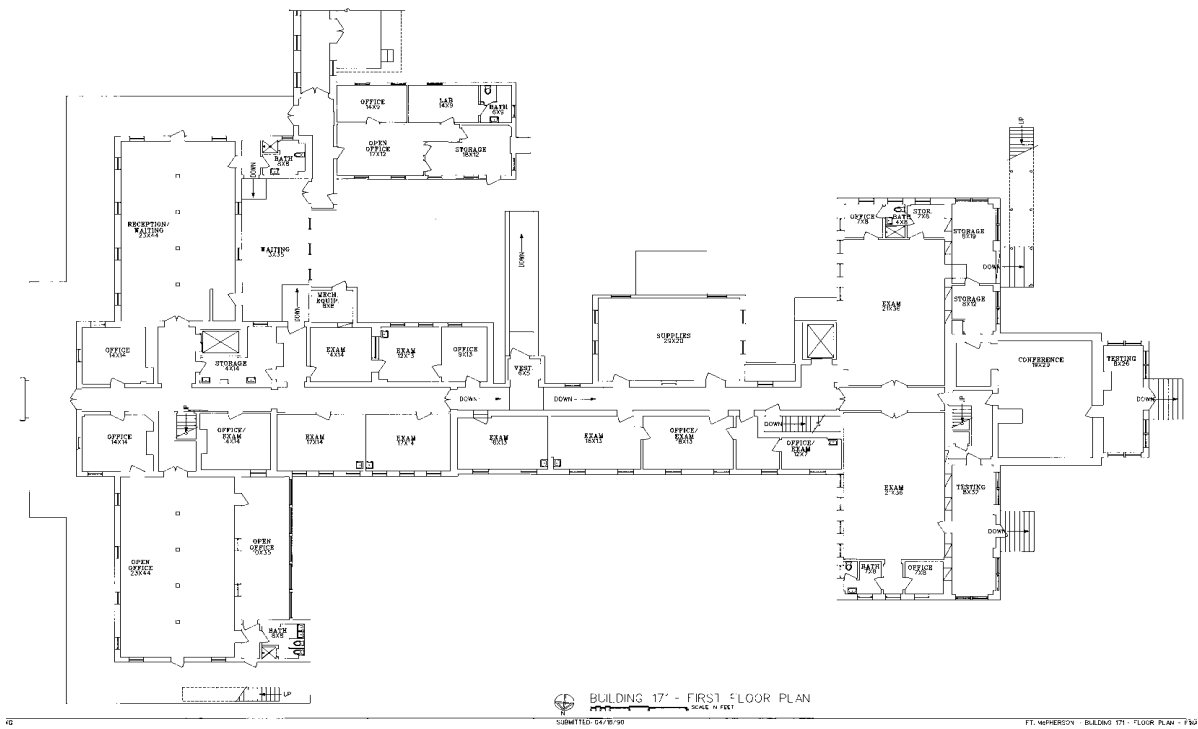
Building 171: Side (north-western section) elevation
