A RESOLUTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE MCPHERSON IMPLEMENTING LOCAL REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

AUTHORITY TO PROCURE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS

A meeting of the members (the "Board of Directors") of the McPherson Implementing Local Redevelopment Authority (the "Authority" or "Fort Mac LRA") was held on the 19th day of October 2017. A quorum was present and voting throughout the aforementioned meeting. Upon motion duly made and seconded, the following resolutions were adopted by the Board of Directors at such meeting: For all purposes hereof, this resolution, as a whole, shall be referred to as the "Resolution"

WHEREAS, the Authority operates a portion of the former Fort McPherson military installation and is charged with redeveloping same which rests inside the territorial limits of the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the sole responsibility for the redevelopment of the former base; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the rehabilitation of the townhomes (formerly duplexes) and certain commercial properties (together "Properties") can generate positive on-going revenue; and

WHEREAS, in order to move forward with the rehabilitation of the townhomes and commercial properties the Authority needs to procure Architectural Design Services to better understand the scope and budget needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Directors endorses and understands the need to rehabilitate the Properties and therefore authorizes the Authority to procure Architectural Services, in an amount not to exceed three hundred ten thousand and 00/100 dollars (\$310,000.00), to assist in the design, scope and estimated cost of the rehabilitation and/or development of the Properties.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the officers of the Authority will return to the Board of Director for further input and approval before undertaking any actual rehabilitation or development of the Properties including but not limited to acquiring the necessary funding to carry out the rehabilitation or development.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all other acts and doings of the officers, employees or agents of the Authority whether done before, on or after the date of adoption of this Resolution which are in conformity with the purposes and intent of this Resolution, and in the furtherance of the execution, delivery, filing and performance of the matters contemplated herein shall be, and the same hereby are, in all respects approved, ratified and confirmed.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any one or more of the provisions herein contained shall be held contrary to any express provision of law or contrary to the policy of express law, though not expressly prohibited, or against public policy, or shall for any reason whatsoever be held invalid, then such covenants, agreements or provisions shall be null and void and shall be deemed separate from the remaining agreements and provisions and shall in no way effect the validity of any of the other agreements and provisions hereof.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the actions provided for in the foregoing resolutions be commenced as soon as practicable.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Authority is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution with the minutes of the proceedings of the Authority.
